

Instructions for submitting an Appeal for Satisfactory Academic Progress:

1. Complete **each section** of this appeal form including major or program, student signature, advisor signature and phone number. In-Progress grades are also required for students enrolled in the current term appealing after the regular appeal deadline, whether appealing for the current semester or a future one. **Incomplete appeals will be returned.** ***Appeals will be accepted for those students with Satisfactory Academic Progress Holds only. Students with a Financial Aid Warning must wait to appeal until they receive a Hold.*
2. Explain in a **detailed letter the extenuating circumstances** that prevented you from meeting the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy standards and how these circumstances have been resolved and will not cause problems in the future. Examples of extenuating circumstances include, but are not limited to: unexpected death or major hospitalization of an immediate family member, extended hospitalization or medical condition of student, house fire, victim of a violent crime. Unexpected employment or work issues beyond the student's control may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
3. **Provide copies of any supporting documentation** such as doctors' letters or bills, death certificate or obituary, or police reports.
4. **For Maximum Credit Standard:** Submit one of the following documents in addition to a detailed letter explaining your specific circumstances and reasoning for exceeding the maximum credit standard, along with supporting documentation, if relevant:
 - **Undergraduate Students** Print the Academic Requirements Report from BroncoWeb.
 - **Graduate Students** Print the Academic Requirements Report from BroncoWeb **OR** submit a copy of the completed Admission to Candidacy Form (available from your department).
5. **Meet with your academic advisor in order to complete the 3rd and 4th pages of this appeal.**
6. **In-Progress Grades:** **In-Progress grades are required for students enrolled in the current term appealing after the regular appeal deadline, whether appealing for the current semester or a future one. Have professors provide in-progress grades in the section on Page 4 for each class in which you are currently enrolled. You may submit letters/emails indicating in-progress grades from each professor with your appeal form. Letters from professors must be on Boise State letterhead and emails must come from the professor's Boise State email address. The professors must provide a letter grade for your work completed thus far in the class (blackboard printouts are not sufficient to meet this requirement).**

Notification of Appeal Results:

After your appeal has been reviewed, you will be notified of the results through BroncoWeb HOLDS and BroncoMail messages.

If your appeal is approved, you will be placed on Financial Aid Probation for one term or on an Academic Plan, if longer than one term is necessary to meet minimum Satisfactory Academic Progress standards. While on Financial Aid Probation or Academic Plan, certain conditions for academic performance will be set and monitored (see Academic Plan page for details). Further financial aid is dependent upon your meeting the conditions for academic performance during the semester(s) for which your appeal was approved. You may experience a delay in receiving financial aid the following term until the Registrar's Office indicates that grades are "Official" and we verify you have met the conditions.

If your appeal is approved, your Academic Plan conditions will continue for each semester until you meet the minimum standards, or you fail to meet the conditions. If you fail the conditions prior to meeting the minimum standard, you will once again be ineligible for financial aid.

Federal regulations require that a student receiving financial aid (including federal and state work-study) make progress toward a degree/certificate according to academic progress standards set by Boise State University. If, after one semester, I am not meeting the minimum comprehensive GPA level **but have met the 3.25 minimum semester comprehensive GPA**, I will be maintained on the Academic Plan conditions as noted above and will be monitored each semester until I am meeting the minimum requirements as outlined in the SAP Policy.

_____ If my appeal is approved, I will be required to **complete 100% of all enrolled credits**. This requirement includes developmental classes such as MATH 025, ENGL 090, etc. Grades of **"I", "F", and "W" or "CW"** will not count as completed and will result in loss of financial aid eligibility.

_____ If my appeal is approved, I will be placed on Financial Aid Probation for one semester. If, after one semester, I am not meeting the minimum Pace standard but have completed 100% of all enrolled credits for the semester, I will be maintained on the Academic Plan conditions as noted above and will be monitored each semester until I have met the minimum 75% Pace requirement.
