The TACO BELL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP at Boise State University is to provide qualified candidates that have proven leadership skills an opportunity to further their education, and develop leadership skills that will be useful in later years.

Amount of Scholarship: \$1500 per school year

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP

1. Scholarship(s) will be awarded annually to a student(s) who is or will be enrolled full time at Boise State University with a GPA of 3.0 or higher in the semester prior to the application.
2. Selection of recipients will be made without regard to race, color, gender, religion or national origin.
3. Other consideration for selection will be, recipient of this scholarship must have held a leadership position and participated in a minimum of one extracurricular activity sponsored by the school or civic group (i.e.-Student Council, Varsity Sports team, Debate Club, Yearbook, Boys Scouts, etc.) Applicant must write a minimum 200-word essay describing their extracurricular activity leadership role, and the importance the leadership role helped play in their academic and social development. A letter of recommendation will also need to be submitted by the sponsoring body where the leadership position was held.
4. Awards will be made without regard to financial need. (Financial Aide's definition.)
5. The Scholarship(s) will not renew automatically. A new application will be required for each scholarship year.
6. Disbursement of award will be credited to the student(s) account.
7. Application deadline is March 15th.
8. Please submit your essay and letter of recommendation to the Financial Aid and Scholarship Office 1910 University Dr. Boise ID 83725-1315. The Financial Aid and Scholarship office is located in the Administrating Building room 113.
