



2018-2019 FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS APPLICATION CHECKLIST



FAFSA

- Request a **Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID)** at fsaid.ed.gov for yourself and at least one parent if you are a dependent student.
- Complete the FAFSA** at fafsa.gov. - Priority Date: February 15, 2018.
- The 2018-19 FAFSA is for fall 2018, spring 2019, summer 2019 aid.
- The Boise State school code is **001616**.
- Use **IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT)** to import 2016 tax data directly to FAFSA.
- Access your **Student Aid Report (SAR)** at fafsa.gov to view notifications regarding your aid eligibility.

New and Transfer Students

- Complete admissions application process by these dates:
December 15, 2017: Non-residents
February 15, 2018: Idaho residents

All Students

- Complete Boise State Scholarship Application online by February 15, 2018.

BRONCOMAIL AND STUDENT CENTER

- Check **my.BoiseState Student Center** for “To-do items” and “Holds”.
- Check BroncoMail weekly. You will receive notification of financial aid awards and other important information via Boise State email.
- Respond quickly and completely to requests for additional information.
- Complete **Direct Deposit information** on my.BoiseState Student Center so any refunds can be sent directly to your bank account.
- Complete **Release of Information form** in the Boise State Registrar’s office to give others (parent or spouse) access to your records.

ACCEPT AID

- Read your BroncoMail award notification, which includes your terms and conditions of financial aid.
- Accept, decline or reduce your award package** via my.BoiseState Student Center.
- First-time loan borrowers:** Complete Direct Loan Entrance Counseling and a Master Promissory Note (eMPN) at studentloans.gov.



PAYING FEES

- Submit and pay your \$100 online Intent to Enroll through Admissions.
- Use online **“Bottom Line Estimator”** on my.Boisestate to determine if you will have a balance or refund.
- Approximately one month before classes start, check your status of financial aid via my.Boisestate Student Center. The **“View Disbursements”** screen on **“View Financial Aid”** page indicates if aid is ready to be applied to fees 10 days before classes begin.
- Monitor your student financial information on my.BoiseState Student Center to ensure your account is paid in full by the payment deadline each semester.
